Protect Your Privacy from Military Recruiters

You may be harassed at home by military recruiters because your name, address and phone number will be given to them by your school. You have a legal right to keep this information private, but you must notify your school office to do so. Some school districts may provide their own forms for this, but they must obey your request no matter how you submit it. You can write your own letter or use the one below. Make sure to keep a copy. It is recommended that a parent or guardian also sign, but this is not required.
