Author(s)/Compiler/Editor/Translator. *Title of Source*. Edition, volume(s), name of publisher, year of publication.

McGee, Glenn. *Beyond Genetics: Putting the Power of DNA to Work in Your Life*. 2<sup>nd</sup> ed., Morrow, 2006.

**NOTE: If there is no author or editor's name on the title page, begin the entry with the title.**

### BOOK WITH TWO AUTHORS

Williamson, Thad, and Gar Alperovitz. *Making a Place for Community: Local Democracy in a Global Era*. Routledge, 2002.

**NOTE: If there are more than 2 authors, the author portion of the citation can be written as follows: Williamson, Thad, et al.**
