FREE TESTS FOR MOST

Plan ahead to have tests at home before you get sick. Available at most pharmacies, no prescription needed. Check with your local pharmacy or retail store.

MEDI-CAL?

Ask the pharmacist for free at-home tests with no co-pay. See <u>Medi-Cal instructions for getting free test kits PDF</u> or scan the QR code to the right.



MEDICARE?

Bring your red, white, and blue Medicare card to a pharmacy to get your free tests. See details at <u>Medicare Covers Over-the-Counter COVID-19</u> <u>Tests</u> or scan the QR code to the right.



PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE?

Your insurance must pay for or reimburse for 8 at-home tests per person per month. There are several ways private insurance offers OTC tests. Some insurance companies will mail them to you directly, some have partnerships with pharmacies and will allow you to pick them up for free, others require you to purchase the test and then fill out a form for reimbursement.
