The District's 2020-21 operating budget does not reflect a structural deficit however, the State Budget still includes over \$11 million in deferrals. The District will pursue short-term financing to cover the cash flow shortfall resulting from the deferrals. These will be repaid in the following year as the deferrals are provided from the state. As of the January Governor's budget, no future deferrals are planned for 2021-22, however, the District will plan appropriately as more information regarding the state's fiscal position is provided.
