# Accreditation Update

- **As a result of the Comprehensive Visit in March 2017, a Follow-Up Report and Visit was required for Fall 2018.**
- **Follow-Up Report required responses and evidence to six compliance recommendations:**
  - Data disaggregation processes and analysis, distance education quality and effectiveness, outcomes analysis and using results for improvement, fiscal management, Board self-evaluation, and delegation of authority to the President
- **November 27, 2018: Follow Up Visit**
- **January 2019: ACCJC Commission Meeting**
  - Commission will take action on Follow-Up Report and Visit
  - Merced College will be notified in late January or early February of 2019

# Enrollment Update

- Summer 2018: 781 FTES
- Fall 2018: 3970 FTES
  - 4650 FTES Goal
  - Does not include positive attendance and/or noncredit
- Spring 2019: 4350 FTES (goal)
  - Updated schedule to meet the needs of students and maximize FTES potential
  - Additional Saturday classes
- Summer 2019: 1001 FTES (goal)
- **TOTAL TARGET: 10,001 FTES**



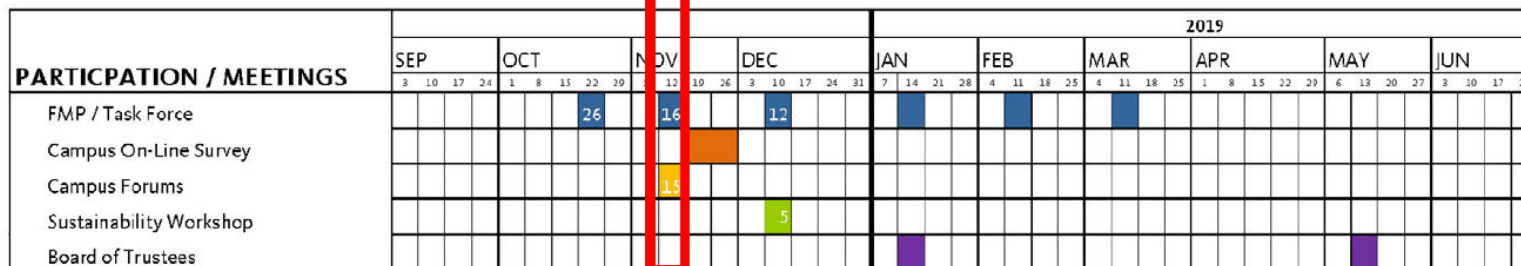
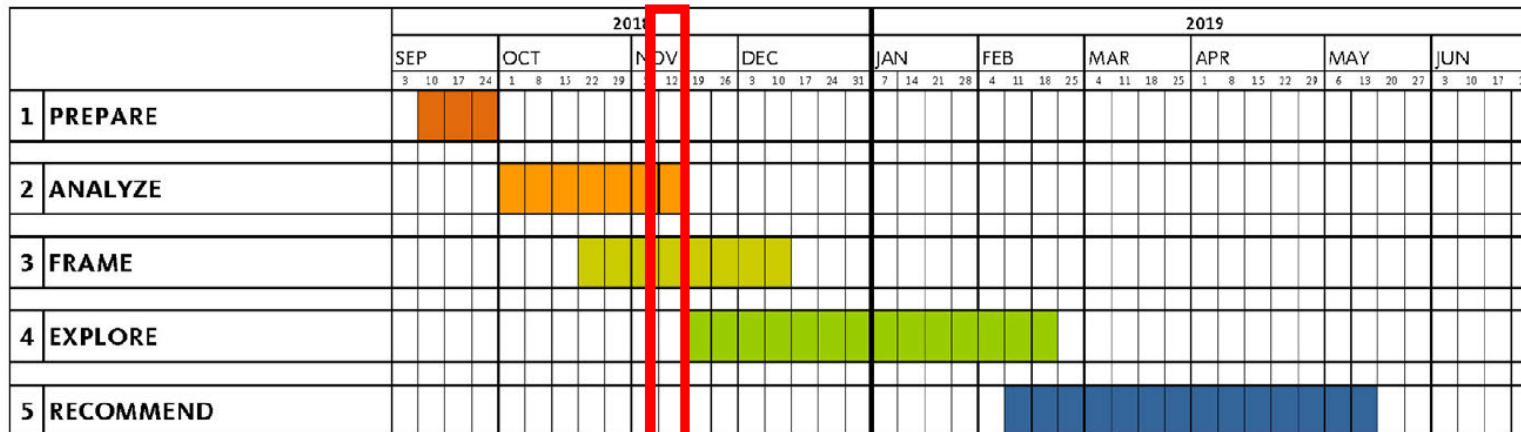


# Facilities Master Plan Update

## PROJECT TIMELINE



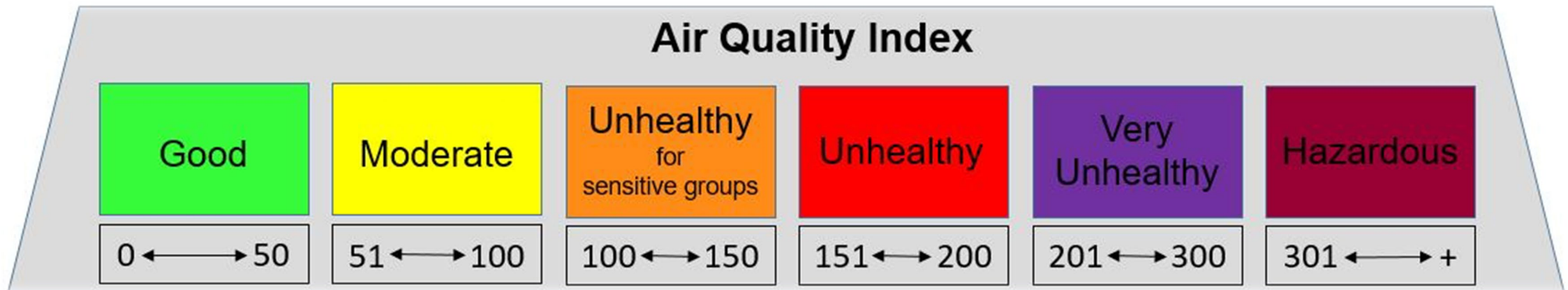
# Human Resources Initiatives

- **Hiring process changes**
  - **Management and Classified Staff hiring, AP 7120**
    - From 14 pages to 3 pages
    - Allows for discussion of applicants
  - **Working on *Contract Faculty Hiring Criteria*, AP 7214**
- **Wellness Program**
  - Wellness committee is putting together a newsletter of all available activities and benefits
  - **Official launch in January: ‘New Year, New You’ concept**
- **Staff Development Surveys**
  - Please participate in survey sent out by your constituency committee member
  - Survey results will establish a baseline of interest in professional development offering and guide the PD Plan



# Recent Campus Closure Debrief

- Closed campus due to several days of poor air quality
