#### **Entrance Requirement**

Limitations on enrollment:

• EMT course, within the last collegiate calendar year, passed with a grade B or better, and successful completion of entrance examination.

• Or, if EMT certification held for greater than one (1) year – proof of field experience and successful completion of entrance examination.

• NREMT EMT Certification or State Certification/Local LEMSA Certification (current), and maintained throughout coursework.

- Minimum 18 years of age.
- BLS Healthcare provider card (current) and maintained throughout the course

• Live scan background clearance (as needed for clinical rotation sites, current sate/local EMT certification will be utilized for application process).

• Health screen clearance

- ENGL-01A or equivalent
- MATH-81 or equivalent
