BE A NOTARY PUBLIC

Sign up to learn how to perform valuable services by certifying or witnessing signatures on official documents, \$15 per signature in 2021. Notary skills are valuable in almost any industry: real estate, legal, medical, and banking to name just a few. This six-hour state-approved seminar gives you the knowledge to pass the exam and practice as an effective Notary. Participants receive 2 practice tests and take the official Notary exam directly following the seminar. You must be present for the entire course of instruction and be at least 18 years of age.
