

CSEA Negotiations

- Successor Agreement runs July 1, 2024 June 30, 2027
- The parties will meet to bargain again in 2026.
- Per Article 16 If the final 2025-26 State budget provides a COLA of at least 2%, there will be an across the board salary schedule adjustment of 3% effective July 1, 2025.
- Stay tuned!



Budget

- May Revise will come out in a few weeks
- Tentative Budget presented to Budget Committee on May 14
- Tentative Budget presented to Board on June 5
- Keeping a close eye on impact of federal actions



Security/Safety

- BRC, Art/Music and Science are fully commissioned for keyless entry
- BRC keycards will be issued to staff this week
- Scheduling a shutdown test for each building (except BRC)
- Expect to issue keycards to Art/Music and Science staff within next 2 weeks
- Allied Health should be fully commissioned this week
- Once keycards are issued, doorstops and Velcro will be removed



Zoom Phones

- Cutover to Zoom Phone is Monday 4/21 at 8:30am.
 - Old phones will stop working at that time
 - The Zoom application will function while desk phones are reconfigured and redistributed
- Users will need to sign into Zoom with their account, not as a guest
- Wired headsets will be distributed for those who requested them. Additionally, a selection of wireless headset options will be available for departments to purchase in the future.
- Old voicemails will not migrate over to the new system. Web access to the old voicemail system will be retained for a while.
