Class Refund Policy

Community Education realizes that extenuating circumstances do arise. If you need to cancel an enrollment, please contact our office at least 7 days prior to the start date. Once an offering begins, fees become nonrefundable. Cash payments will be refunded by check and will arrive via mail. Credit card payments will be refunded as a credit back to the same card that was used. Refunds take approximately 4-6 weeks to process.

- Community Education reserves the right to cancel any class. Full refunds are automatically granted if a class is canceled by our office.
- College for Kids reserves the right to change a student's schedule if he/she has been enrolled in a class that is not consistent with the student's appropriate age/grade level.

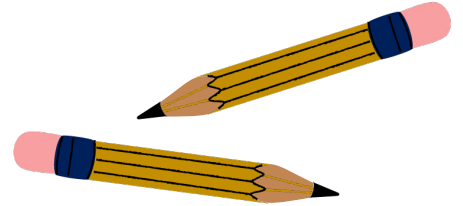


Description:

What is College for Kids?

We provide safe activities for summer fun and learning. We have classes and camps to accommodate most ages. Our classes are designed to stimulate curiosity, reinforce basic skills, help kids discover new subjects, and, most of all, help your child make lasting memories!

Where will the classes be held?

Some classes are held at the Los Banos Community Center and some are held at the Los Banos Campus of Merced College

What are the age ranges to register for classes?

Enrichment classes are available to students going into 2nd grade through 8th grade. Exact ages/grade levels can be found in class descriptions throughout the brochure.

What does registration cover?

The registration covers all class/camp enrollment fees and supplies unless otherwise specified. It does not cover the cost of snacks, meals, or other related expenses.

What if my child becomes sick?

If your child has a temperature or is complaining of an upset stomach, earache, severe cold, undetermined rash, or other symptoms of illness, he/she will be escorted to our office and you will be contacted to pick up your child.

What time and where can I drop my child off and pick him/her up?

Parent/guardian must accompany their child to the designated classroom. Please be on time to pick up your child. Should there be any changes to your child's schedule, or any absences, please call Community Education staff at (209) 384-6224. Office staff will notify the instructor.

Will my child be escorted to and from class?

Parents will be responsible for dropping off and picking up their child(ren). If your child is taking classes at both sites, the parent will be responsible for the transport.

May I attend class with my child?

We ask that you not enter the classroom while the class is in session. Our instructors and staff have passed clearance to work with children to ensure their safety. Many classes have either projects to take home or presentations that will be given on the last day. Parents will be invited to attend presentations.
