Steward's Corner: Navigating Tough Talks with Confidence

Welcome to the *Steward's Corner*, a new section in our newsletter where we share practical tips and strategies for handling workplace situations professionally and effectively. This month, we're focusing on how to discuss complex leave requests with your manager—especially when time is tight, and you're waiting on a response. Below is a sample scenario to guide you through the process, from start to finish.

Scenario: Requesting Vacation Time (Article 20 - Vacation Scheduling)

March 26th

Member: "Hi, I'd like to take a two-week vacation from September 16th to 27th to join friends on a cruise. We need to confirm with them by April 4th. Would this work with the schedule? I'll submit the leave request if it does. I don't have enough hours yet, but I'll accrue them over the next two months."

Manager: "Let me check the schedule and get back to you."

Member: "Thanks! I'll send a quick email to recap our talk for the record." *Action:* Member emails the manager summarizing the discussion.

April 2nd (No response yet)

Member (Email Reply): "Hi, just a friendly reminder that you were checking the schedule for my September $16^{th} - 27^{th}$ vacation request. We need to let our friends know by Friday, or we'll miss out. Thanks for your help!"

April 3rd

Manager (Email Reply): "Yes, you're approved. Go ahead and submit the leave request with your current hours, then add the extra days as you accrue them."
