

TB Testing & Flu (Influenza) Vaccine

TB:

Students must have a TB skin test or QuantiFERON-TB (QFT) blood test or negative chest x-ray.

TB tests & chest x-rays are good for 1 year. Your test must remain valid (not expire) while you're taking the class.

Flu (Influenza) Vaccine:

The flu vaccine is seasonal. Spring - required at time of application; Summer - not required; Fall - required once it becomes available, usually around September

Registered Merced College Students –

Student Health Services provides free TB testing & flu vaccinations (when available) to **current** Merced College students who have paid their Student Health Fee. Contact them for current offerings and to schedule an appointment.
