


How to Set Up Password Less Sign-In and Use an App Instead of a Password

This guide provides step-by-step instructions to set up password less sign-in requests using the Microsoft Authenticator app and shows how to use the app to sign in instead of entering your password.


Step 1: Open Microsoft Authenticator App

Open the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device. In the app, click on your school / work account you will see options for other ways to sign in. Select '**Set up passwordless sign-in requests**'.




Step 2: Enable Password Less Sign-In

Once you select the passwordless option in step one and authenticate, your account will show that passwordless sign-in is enabled. This means you can now use your device to sign in without typing your password.




Step 3: Change Default Sign-In Method in Security Info

Go to <https://aka.ms/mysecurityinfo> page and sign in. Under '**Most advisable sign-in method where it applies,**' click on '**Change**'. From the list of options, select '**App based authentication or hardware token - code**'. This ensures that you will use the app-based code instead of your password.



When you go to sign in to your Merced College account, you will see the usual login page asking for a password. Instead of entering your password, click on 'Use an app instead'.



Step 4: Approve the Sign-In Request

A prompt will appear on your device through the Authenticator app. Approve the sign-in request by entering the number shown on the screen. This completes the sign-in process without needing your password from now onwards.
