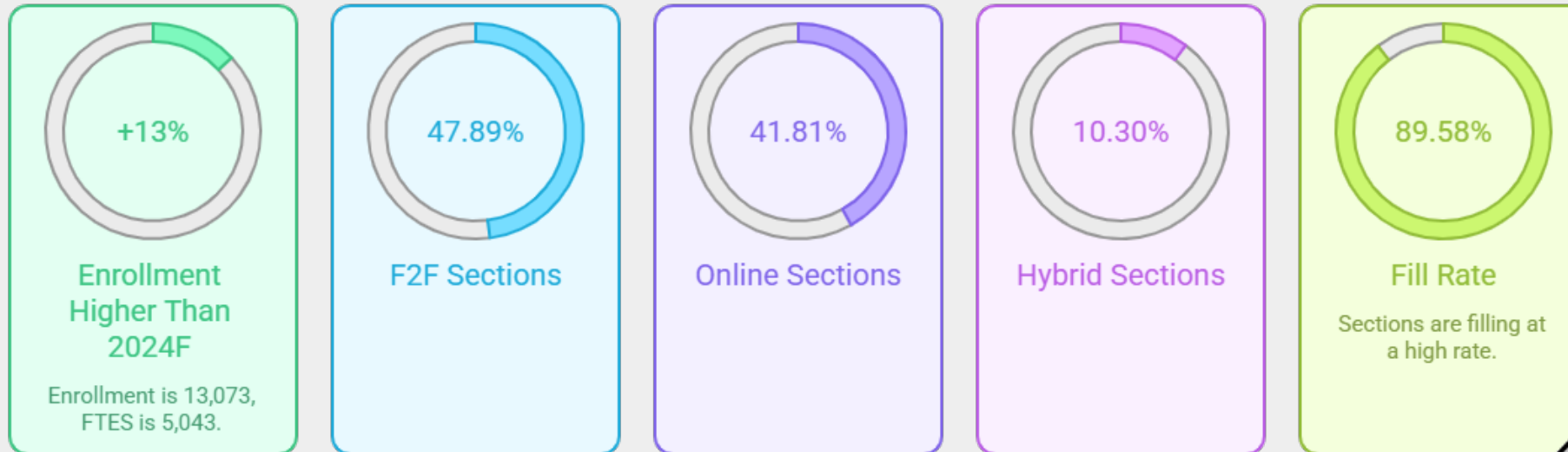

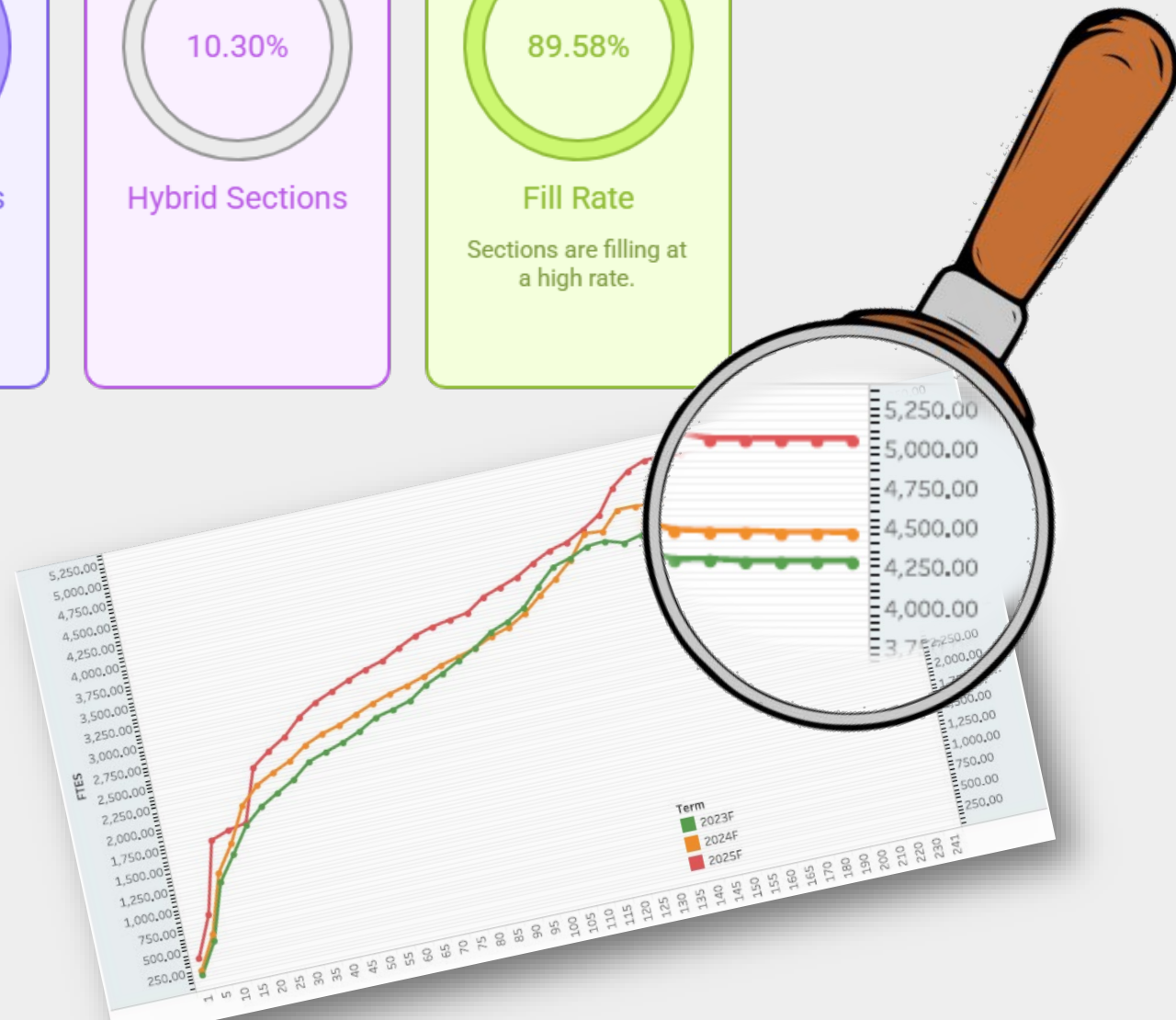

Spring Classes – FTES/Cancellations

- Actual FTES for 2024-25 was 10,735 while the funded FTES was 10,175
 - For context, one 3-unit class with 50 students generates a little over 5 FTES
- For 2025-26 we have about 1,000 FTES from summer and looking at over 5,000 FTES for fall
- For spring 2026 we are being careful about the number of sections we offer.

 - Other courses that meet requirement

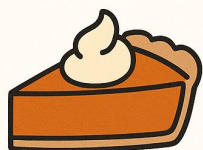
Hiring – Spring

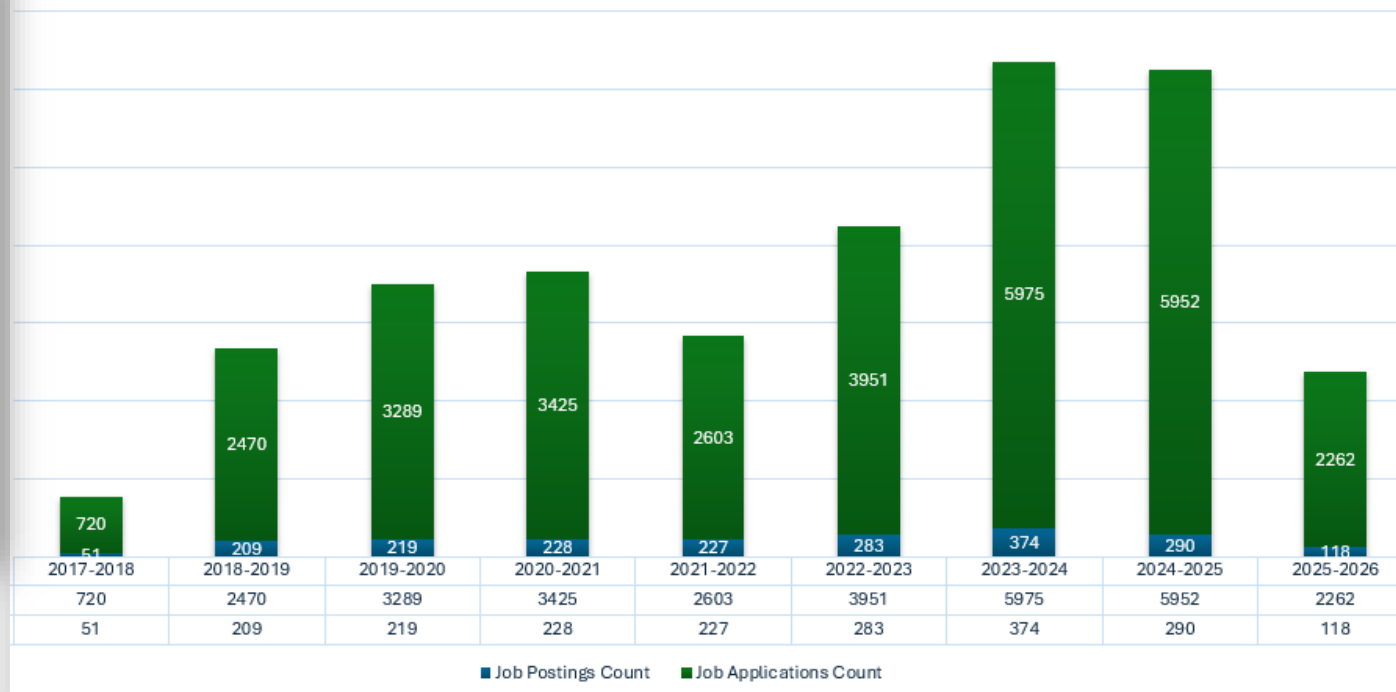

- Government Shutdown Impact on Merced College
 - CalFresh benefits delayed/interrupted
 - Merced College Basic Needs Center and Food Pantry are available
 - For qualifying students, EOPS/CalWORKs provides assistance
 - Financial Aid provides assistance
 - Students experiencing anxiety can reach out to Student Health or use TimelyCare
 - Community Resources, such as the Merced County Food Bank, are available to students
 - Merced Fire Fighters Scholars Foundation
- DHSI Grant is the only Merced College program that has been discontinued due to changes at the Federal level

Keyless Access

- Los Banos, BRC, and most buildings on the Merced Campus are operational
